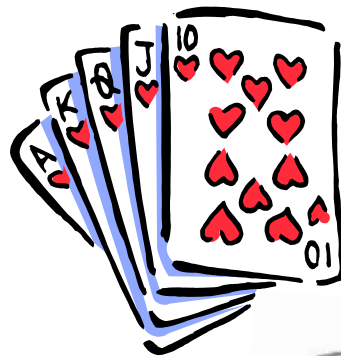

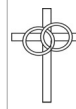

### Pro-Life Corner

New statistics from the state health department in Minnesota show the number of abortions there have dropped to the lowest point since 1975, thanks in part to a program that provides help for pregnant women. Abortion numbers fell for the fourth straight year. The decrease follows a trend of fewer abortions statewide since the Positive Alternatives program began in July 2006, funding efforts to help pregnant women in need. The annual report shows a total of 11,505 abortions were done in Minnesota in 2010, more than seven percent fewer than the 12,388 done in 2009. Positive Alternatives is one of several pro-life legislative efforts by Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life (MCCCL) to offer women life-affirming alternatives to abortion. Others include the Woman's Right to Know informed consent law, and the parental notification law for minors considering abortion. The state health department shows more than 25,000 women statewide were helped through the Positive Alternatives program in its first four years (July 2006-June 2010).
