Do we judge others?

In our human nature, one of the greatest mistakes we sometimes make is to judge others. We take one look at a person, and we might think that they are a sinner, a pagan, a person that does not treat their parents well, etc. We think they are bad people, that they do not know Christ, but in reality, we have no idea what is going on in the heart of that person. We do not know their struggles, their faith, where they have been, nor where they are striving to go in life.

However, as we interact with other people, we must make judgments about their words and actions so that we can respond to them appropriately. For example, when we purchase something, we need to decide whether the seller is being honest about the product's quality and price. But we cannot think that just because they are trying to sell us an Ipad for more than it's worth that

they are going to hell. That is only for God to decide.

We must also look at ourselves. We might think that others say mean things, don't go to Sunday Mass, don't help their aging grandparents, but what about you and me? **"Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own eye? How can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove that splinter from your eye', while the wooden beam is in your eye? You hypocrite remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter from your brother's eye."** Matthew 7:3-5
